I'll never forget my first day in Australia. I was warmly welcomed by my Redemptorist community of different nationalities and ages. In Bundaberg, I am once more deeply impressed by the hospitality and friendship of the "Bundies". I think when different cultures join in harmony with one another, people will become more like an extended family.
